Per Brooke Newman I am including, in addition to copy of my letter to the editor Page News & Courier, two problematic areas on Main Street.

Intersection of Main Street and Reservoir Avenue.

There is an existing traffic light, marked crosswalk, and I believe a sign with a pedestrian symbol on a power pole.

Vehicles making a left or right turn onto Reservoir or onto Main Street, are not stopping for pedestrians or individuals in a mobility chair. They are turning in front, very close to all, even though the pedestrian or power chair is half-way across the crosswalk.

Vehicles are driving through the crosswalk even when pedestrians or those in mobility chairs are half-way across Main Street.

The above intersections/crosswalks are only two of the problematic crossings in Luray for pedestrians or those in mobility chairs.

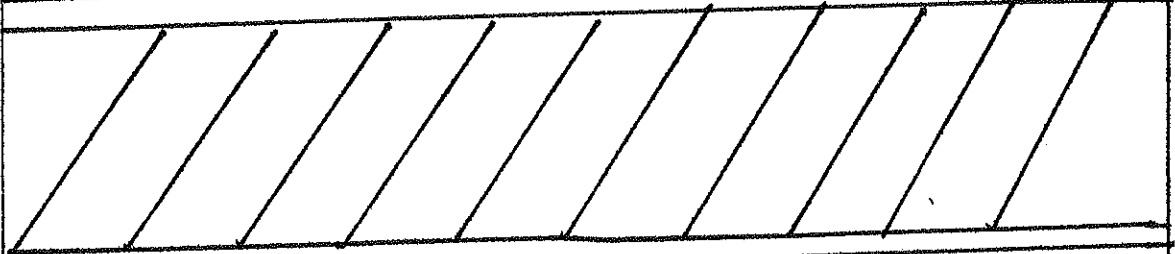

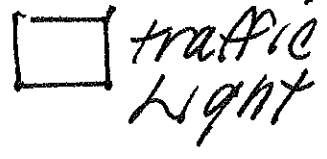
