PUBLIC NOTICE

March 12, 2019

At their March 11, 2019 Council Meeting, the Luray Town Council reviewed the following issues and took the following actions.

Under the Consent Agenda item:

- 1) Council unanimously approved minutes from the February 11th Council Meeting and the February 26th Work Session, February Financial Reports, and the Accounts Payable checks.

Under the Citizen Comments agenda item:

- 1) Rose Ann Smythe of 127 South Court Street spoke regarding the historical significance of the Greenhill Cemetery and the need for continued community support.
- 2) Will Daniels of 40 Greenfield Road spoke in support of the work accomplished by the Friends of the Green Hill Cemetery Association.
- 3) Lisa Smith of 5 South Broad Street requested additional signage be considered directing visitors to the public parking areas in Downtown.
- 4) Audre King spoke about the renovation work beyond conducted on the former Andrew Jackson School into a community center for Page County youth. He requested that Council consider providing relief for the sanitary sewer connection fees for the facility.

Under the Presentations agenda item:

Under the Public Hearings item:

1. Town Council conducted a public hearing to receive input on a request from the Hotel Laurance for a Special Use Permit to install four flags on the north face of the building that extend into the Right-of-Way over the West Main Street sidewalk. No speakers spoke at the public hearing. Council unanimously approved (Pence Abstain) the Special Use Permit for the Hotel Laurance to install four flags up to twenty square feet in area each extending into the public Right-of-Way with the following conditions: 1) Applicant shall maintain liability insurance in excess of \$1,000,000 coverage with the Town identified as an additional insured; 2) signs shall be maintained in non-frayed and non-faded condition; 3) flag support attachments be anchored and secured with sufficient redundancy to reduce risk of detachment with bolts through the entire outer brick and brackets that secure the pole with bolts; and 4) appropriate lighting be provided if possible.

Under the Departments, Town Boards, and Commission agenda item:

- 1) Bryan Chrisman, Assistant Town Manager, provided an update to the West Main Street Bridge Construction project. Orders Construction has completed installation of the deck pans that will be used to support the concrete slab, which is scheduled to be poured in late March or early April. Under the Action & Discussion agenda item:

- 1) Town Council unanimously adopted amendments to Code Section 70-6.a to prohibit the dumping of offsite waste of waste containers provided for onsite use in Parks and along the Greenway.
- 2) Town Council unanimously approved the Proclamation recognizing March 24th to March 31st at “Luray American Legion Centennial Week”.
- 3) Town Council unanimously approved the 2018 Planning Commission Annual Report.
- 4) Town Council unanimously approved the donation of the Town’s older “bounce house” to the Town of Stanley.
- 5) Town Council unanimously approved an Ordinance adopting reduced speed limits on West Main Street and Leaksville Road in the area of the future roundabout.
