April 9, 2019

At their April 8, 2019 Council Meeting, the Luray Town Council reviewed the following issues and took the following actions.

Under the Consent Agenda item:

- 1) Council unanimously approved minutes from the March 11th Council Meeting and the March 26th Work Session, February Financial Reports, and the Accounts Payable checks.

Under the Citizen Comments agenda item:

- 1) John Mayeux of 37 Wallace Avenue presented an overview of the April 27th Earth Day Event that is scheduled for the Mechanic Street Parking Lot area near the Greenway.

Under the Presentations agenda item:

Under the Public Hearings item:

1. Town Council conducted a public hearing to receive input on a Budget Amendment to the FY 2019 Budget to increase the budget by \$2,476,010 due to the accelerated construction and reimbursement of funds from the state and federal grant programs for construction of the West Main Street Bridge. No citizens spoke at the Public Hearing. Town Council unanimously approved the Budget Amendment.

Under the Departments, Town Boards, and Commission agenda item:

- 1) Gina Hilliard with the Chamber of Commerce informed Town Council that the Chamber hired Joanne Kane as their Chamber and Tourism Assistant, joined the PCTC Advisory Council, has applied for a VTC grant, and was awarded a VTC Grant for the "50 Years of Love" celebration. Ms. Hilliard reminded the public that the Page County Outdoor Movie Night in Luray is Thursday June 13th at Dean Park.
- 2) Meredith Dees invited Town Council to the May 17th Chicken Chow Down event and reminded citizens that they could still participate in the raffle to be the first driver across the new West Main Street Bridge.
- 3) Bryan Chrisman, Assistant Town Manager, provided an update to the West Main Street Bridge Construction project. Orders Construction has completed installation of the concrete deck, and curing of the concrete should continue over the next few weeks. The concrete should be cured enough to allow the sidewalks to be poured the week of April 16th and the deck rail the week of the 23rd. The bridge is anticipated to be opened to traffic in June. Photos and videos of the demolition can be found at the "See Imagery" button at www.luraybridge.com. Mr. Chrisman also informed Town Council that the mast arms for the traffic signal

at Main Street and Memorial Drive is scheduled for installation April 9th through the 10th. Once installed, the traffic signal will be energized and left on “flash” for two weeks before being activated for traffic control.

Under the Action & Discussion agenda item:

- 1) Town Council unanimously adopted the Guidelines for Submission and Consideration of Proposals related to the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002. These guidelines will be added to the Town’s website to allow the use of public-private partnerships for future Town projects.
- 2) Town Council unanimously approved the execution of an agreement with the Luray Little League, Inc. to allow the League to use Town equipment to maintain the baseball fields at Dean Park during their season.
- 3) Town Council reviewed a draft of a Fund Balance Policy to establish guidelines for fund reserve levels. Council will consider adoption of this policy as part of the adoption of the FY 2020 Budget.
- 4) Town Council reviewed the Enterprise Fund portions of the proposed FY 2020 Budget.
