### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

September 10, 2019

At their September 9, 2019 Council Meeting, the Luray Town Council reviewed the following issues and took the following actions.

Under the Consent Agenda item:

- 1) Council unanimously approved minutes from the August 12<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting and the Accounts Payable checks.

Under the Citizen Comments agenda item:

No speakers spoke

Under the Public Hearings item:

No Public Hearings scheduled

Under the Departments, Town Boards, and Commission agenda item:

No updates provided

Under the Action & Discussion agenda item:

- 1) Town Council unanimously approved repealing Sections 46, 48, 49, 50, and 51 of Chapter 82 of the Town Code to eliminate references to Town stickers issued as proof of payment for vehicle License Fees.
- 2) Town Council discussed a Code Amendment to Section 406.2 of Article IV – District Regulation of Appendix A – Zoning to allow existing single-family dwellings in the Business B1 District be excluded from the Special Use Permit requirement if properties experience a change of use back to residential use and were constructed prior to 1974. Council also confirmed that expansion of an existing residential use would not require a Special Use Permit. A Public Hearing will be scheduled for the October Town Council Meeting.
- 3) Town Council discussed a request from Douglas Frye to consider supporting the dedication of the Bixler's Ferry Road Bridge of Route 211 in memory of Emmet Dougans, the first Page County resident killed during the Vietnam War. Page County is currently working with VDOT on this request, and the Town could adopt a Resolution of Support once the County proceeds with the dedication application.



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- 4) Town Council unanimously adopted the Proclamation for Construction Week as the week of September 17<sup>th</sup> in the Town as requested by the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Under the Old Business item:

- 1) Town Council discussed the draft updates to the Town's Personnel Policies Manual and our Job Descriptions. Town Council requested a comparison of the proposed salary ranges in the draft Job Descriptions versus the Springsted Salary Study for the next Work Session.
- 2) Town Council discussed the draft Code Amendment to Chapter 98 of the Town Code. The draft revisions would update the Chapter from "Waterways" to "Parks and Recreation Facilities" to address all Parks. Council will continue discussion as the September Work Session.

Under the Town Attorney's Report item:

- 1) Town Attorney Jason Botkins reminded Town Council the Commonwealth's requirement that all elected officials complete Conflict of Interest Act training by December 31<sup>st</sup>. He further informed Council that a training seminar had been scheduled in Woodstock that would fulfill this educational requirement.

Under the Closed Meeting item:

- 1) Town Council convened in Closed Meeting for the purpose of discussion of the disposition of publicly held real property, as authorized by Section 2.2-3711(A)(d) of the Code of Virginia, specifically to discuss the disposition of 36 West Main Street. Following the adjournment of the Closed Meeting, Town Council reconvened in Open Session and unanimously certified the Closed Meeting discussion.
