October 10, 2018

At their October 9, 2018 Council Meeting, the Luray Town Council reviewed the following issues and took the following actions.

Under the Consent Agenda item:

- 1) Council unanimously approved minutes from the September 10<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting and the September 25<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting, and the Accounts Payable checks.

Under the Citizen Comments agenda item:

No citizens spoke.

Under the Public Hearings agenda item:

- 1) Council conducted a Public Hearing to receive comment on the proposed amendments to the Town Charter. No citizens spoke at the Public Hearing. Following the closing of the hearing, the Town Council unanimously adopted a Resolution approving the form of the Charter Amendment and requesting the General Assembly to consider approving the Charter Amendment at the next session.

Under the Departments, Town Boards, and Commission agenda item:

- 1) Meredith Dees with the Luray Downtown Initiative provided Council an update on their recent Construction and Cocktails event, announced that the new Fall banners had been placed Downtown, provided a copy of the new Downtown Guide, and provided an overview of the upcoming events: Downtown Halloween from 4pm to 7pm on October 31<sup>st</sup> and Small Business Saturday on November 24<sup>th</sup>, and let Town Council know that an application to the Town's Revolving Loan Program had been received.
- 2) Bryan Chrisman, Assistant Town Manager, provided a written update to the West Main Street Bridge Construction project. Due to the heavy rains, the sewer relocation work, and time for pile installation, the project is now approximately two weeks behind schedule.
