Charcoal grills are located at the six picnic shelters, & also scattered throughout the park. Restrooms are centrally located.

August 24 & 25, 2019

Aug. 31, Sept. 1 & 2, 2019

Monday-Saturday 11am – 6pm

Sunday noon – 6pm

Fishermen can bring their own *non-gas-powered boats* and fish with a valid State of VA & Town of Luray fishing + boating license.

Fishing & boating permits are sold at the Town Office, Fairview Grocery, & Wal-Mart.

DIRECTIONS TO LAKE ARROWHEAD

From the traffic light on East Main Street, take Reservoir Avenue 2.6 miles (Reservoir will turn into Fairview Road) to a stop sign. Turn right onto Brookstone Road, go 1/10 mile, turn left onto Valley Burg Road. Go 1.3 miles to the Lake Arrowhead entrance on the left. (Note: Valley Burg Road will turn to the right prior to the Lake entrance – keep going straight on Lake Arrowhead Road.)

There are brown signs along the way!

LAKE ARROWHEAD

Lake Arrowhead Park is a 134-acre recreation area located 3 miles outside the Luray town limits. Built in the early 1970's, the park has a 34-acre lake with fishing, boating, and a white sand beach for swimming. A one-mile hiking trail takes visitors through wooded areas that circle the entire lake. Six picnic shelters, a playground area, and handicapped accessible restrooms help make Lake Arrowhead an ideal place for visitors of all ages and abilities.

The park is open year-round!
