

LAKE ARROWHEAD

Lake Arrowhead Park is a 134-acre recreation area located 4 miles outside the Luray town limits. Built in the early 1970's, the park has a 34-acre lake with fishing, boating, and a white sand beach for swimming. A 1 mile hiking trail takes visitors through wooded areas that circle the entire lake. 6 picnic shelters, playground areas, and handicapped accessible restrooms help make Lake Arrowhead an ideal place for visitors of all ages!

Beach volleyball and horseshoe pits are available in addition to a playing field for baseball and softball. Horseshoes and volleyballs can be checked-out at the Swimming Beach Concession Stand from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Swimming Fees

Ages 3-12: \$2.00 per day Ages 13-18: \$2.50 per day Ages 19 & up: \$3.00 per day
A small concession stand sells snacks and drinks at the swimming beach in season.

Annual Lake Arrowhead Swimming Season Passes:

Can be purchased at the Luray Town Office located at 45 East Main Street between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.

Season Pass Pricing:

Single Pass – \$25.00

Couple's Passes – \$40.00

Family Passes – \$60.00

All family members must have the same household address

Annual Fees For Fishing Permits Or Boating Permits

\$3.00 for residents within town limits \$5.00 for non-residents

Disabled persons and persons over age 65 may obtain permits at no charge.

Persons under the age of 16 are not required to have a permit.

Fishermen can bring their own non-gas powered boats and fish with a valid State of Virginia fishing license and a Town of Luray fishing permit. Fishing permits and boating permits are available at the Luray Town Office, Wal-Mart, Fairview Grocery, Southern States, or Bill's Guns & Taxidermy.

Kayak & Canoe Rentals

Canoes and kayaks are available for rent from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

Kayaks: \$5.00 per person, per 30 minutes.

Canoes: \$4.00 per person, per 30 minutes.

Shelter Rentals At Lake Arrowhead

Small Shelter: Capacity approximately 30 persons - \$35.00 (Beta Sigma Phi)

Medium Shelters: Capacity approximately 50 persons - \$40.00 (FFA & Town of Luray)

Large Shelters: Capacity approximately 100 persons - \$45.00 (Ruritan/Modern Woodman/Lions)

Cook out grills are located at the 6 picnic shelters and restrooms are centrally located.

Shelter Rentals At The Ralph H. Dean Recreation Park

Rotary Shelter: Capacity approximately 75 persons - \$45.00

Class of '71 Shelter: Capacity approximately 100 persons - \$45.00

Directions to Lake Arrowhead

From the traffic light on East Main Street, take Reservoir Avenue 2.6 miles (Reservoir will turn into Fairview Road) to a stop sign. Turn right onto Brookstone Road, go 1/10 mile, turn left onto Valley Burg Road. Go 1.3 miles to the Lake Arrowhead entrance on the left. (Note: Valley Burg Road will turn to the right prior to the Lake entrance – keep going straight on Lake Arrowhead Road.) There are signs along the way!!
