

LAKE ARROWHEAD

Lake Arrowhead is a 134-acre recreation area located just 4 miles outside the Luray town limits. Built in the early 1970's, the park has a beautiful 34-acre lake with opportunities to fish, boat, and even go for a swim in the lake or relax on the white sand beach! There is also a hiking trail stretching 1 mile around the entire lake that takes visitors through wooded areas with a beautiful view of Shenandoah National Park. The park has 6 picnic shelters, playground areas, and handicap accessible restrooms that help make Lake Arrowhead an ideal place for visitors of all ages!

Annual Lake Arrowhead Swimming Season Passes can be purchased at the Luray Town Office located at 45 East Main Street between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm, Monday - Friday.

ANNUAL BOATING AND/OR FISHING PERMITS

\$5.00 for residents within town limits

\$7.00 for non-residents

Disabled persons and persons over age 65 may obtain permits at no charge.

Persons under the age of 16 are *not* required to have a permit.

Anglers can bring their own non-gas powered boats and fish with a valid State of VA fishing license and a Town of Luray fishing permit.

Fishing permits as well as boating permits are available at the Luray Town Office, Wal-Mart, & Fairview Grocery.

You will need one of each if you are boating **and fishing!*

DIRECTIONS TO LAKE ARROWHEAD

From the traffic light on East Main Street, take Reservoir Avenue 2.6 miles.

Reservoir will turn into Fairview Road. You will reach a stop sign.

Turn right onto Brookstone Road and go 1/10 mile. Turn left onto Valley Burg Road.

Go 1.3 miles to the Lake Arrowhead entrance, it will be on your left.

Note: Valley Burg Road will turn to the right prior to the Lake entrance – keep going straight on Lake Arrowhead Road. There will be brown signs along the way. Enjoy!
