COVID-19 RESPONSE PHASE II

Based upon the Commonwealth of Virginia entering Phase II of COVID-19 reopening, The Town of Luray will open our Park facilities following the Governor's and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) requirements and recommendation on Saturday, June 6, 2020.

Gatherings will be limited to fifty (50) people.

We plan to sanitize our restrooms on a two-hour rotation as recommended by the CDC. The sanitizing process includes the use of a low bleach content mixture of water sprayed on surfaces that receive regular use such as door handles, fixture handles, and counters. The door of the restroom would then be left open for five minutes to allow the cleaned surfaces to air dry.

Outdoor playgrounds are challenging to ensure appropriate sanitizing measures. We will install signage at our playgrounds recommending hand washing after use.

The Lake Arrowhead beach will be open for use. Initially, however, the snack shack will be closed, and no lifeguards will be present. Use of the beach will be at the discretion of visitors and will be at their own risk. Rules posted for activities at the beach will continue to be enforced.

June events will be postponed until a future time and date.

We plan to only launch fireworks on the Fourth of July. Partnering with the Page County Fairgrounds, fireworks will be launched from the Fairgrounds around 9:15 pm to allow a greater viewing area throughout Town.

The Town's collection of recycling materials continues to be suspended until work release from the Jail resumes.
