THE PARKS OF LURAY, VA

LAKE ARROWHEAD



Located approximately 2 miles outside of Town of Luray limits, just below Skyline Drive, Lake Arrowhead is a picturesque setting featuring a 34 acre lake with fishing, boating, canoe and kayak rentals, a white sand beach for swimming and a concession stand. The park area includes picnic shelters, restroom facilities, a baseball field,

playground areas, scout camping area and a network of marked, scenic hiking trails.

RALPH H. DEAN RECREATIONAL PARK

This 58 acre park was constructed in the early 1990s and features scenic mountain views, multiple ball fields, a large wooden playground, as well as a 1 mile fitness trail with 20 workout stations, 9 hole Frisbee golf course, skate park. There are also several picnic shelters with rental options available.



LURAY-HAWKSBILL GREENWAY



Situated along the Hawksbill Creek in downtown Luray, this linear park features a 10' wide paved walking pathway with benches and picnic tables that parallel the Trout-stocked Hawksbill Creek. The Greenway includes a beautiful plaza area with swings, an arbor, and a small cliffside pocket park with beautiful

landscaping, drinking fountain, picnic tables and benches. Two trailside comfort stations are on-site. The trail is approximately 2 miles in total distance.

POCKET PARKS

Throughout the Town of Luray are four pocket parks: Cave Pond Park, Eugene Park, Slye Park, and Inn Lawn Park. These scenic areas offer various amenities such as small ponds, gazebos, picnic and play areas, and beautiful mountain views.
