ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL**Secs. 66-1—66-30. Reserved.****ARTICLE II. YARD SALES; GARAGE SALES****Sec. 66-31. Activities subject to this article.**

All yard sales, lawn sales, porch sales, attic sales, garage sales, room sales, backyard sales, patio sales, flea market sales, rummage sales and sales from within dwellings and other structures not being retail or wholesale stores are subject to the provisions hereof.

Sec. 66-32. License—Required.

It shall be unlawful for any person or organization to conduct any such sale, work at any such sale, advertise any such sale, or display property which would reasonably appear to be for any such sale, or anyone owning property or leasing the same who permits any of the foregoing to take place on such property, to do so without first securing a license therefor. Only one license shall be required for any such sale, and it may be issued in the name of the property owner or lessee, or in the name of the person responsible for conducting the sale.

Sec. 66-33. Same—Application, affidavit, required information, fee, duration of sale.

(a) Such license shall be issued by the town clerk's office upon proper application at least seven days in advance of such sale. Prior to the issuance of the license for any such sale, the individuals conducting such sale shall file a written, sworn statement or affidavit of the applicant with the town office, at least seven days in advance of the proposed sale, setting forth the following information:

- (1) Full name and address of applicant.
- (2) The location at which the proposed sale is to be held.

(3) The date, or dates, upon which the sale shall be held.

(4) The date, or dates, of any other such sale within the current calendar year.

(5) An affirmative statement that the property to be sold was owned by the applicant as his own personal property and was neither acquired or consigned for the purposes of resale.

(b) There shall be no fee imposed for the license for the first two of any such sales during any calendar year. No such sale shall last longer than three consecutive days. There shall be a license fee of \$20.00 for all such sales in excess of the first two during any calendar year.

Sec. 66-34. Daily hours.

Any sale conducted pursuant to the provisions hereof shall be limited in time to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Sec. 66-35. Posting of signs.

No signs shall be posted anywhere in the town advertising such sales, except that the property owner, lessee or the person responsible for conducting the sale may install on the property where the sale is being conducted one sign not larger than four square feet. Said sign shall be posted not more than 48 hours prior to the date of the sale and shall be removed at the end of the last day upon which the sale is held.

Sec. 66-36. Impeding vehicular or pedestrian traffic prohibited.

No personal property sold or offered for sale shall be placed, kept or displayed on or in any public right-of-way or in any manner so as to interfere with or impede the flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

Periodic sales held exclusively at churches or other places of worship, public or private schools,
