CODE OF THE TOWN OF LUARY, VIRGINIA

Article II. Yard Sales; Garage Sales

Section 66-31 Activities subject to this article

All yard sales, lawn sales, porch sales, attic sales, garage sales, room sales, backyard sales, patio sales, rummage sales and sales from within dwellings and other structures not being retail or wholesale stores are subject to the provisions hereof.

Section 66-32 License-Required

It shall be unlawful for any person or organization to conduct any such sale, work at any such sale, advertise any such sale, or display property which would reasonably appear to be for any such sale, or anyone owning property or leasing the same who permits any of the foregoing to take place on such property, to do so without first securing a license therefore. Only one license shall be issued in the name of the property owner or lessee, or in the name of the person responsible for conducting the sale.

Section 66-33 Same-Application, affidavit, required information, fee, duration of sale

(a) Such license shall be issued by the town clerk's office upon proper application at least seven days in advance of such sale. Prior to the issuance of the license for any such sale, the individuals conducting such sale shall file a written, sworn statement or affidavit of the applicant with the town office, at least seven days in advance of the proposed sale, setting forth the following information:

1. Full name and address of applicant
2. The location at which the proposed sale is to be held.
3. The date, or dates, upon which the sale shall be held.
4. The date, or dates, of any other such sale within the current calendar year.
5. An affirmative statement that the property to be sold was owned by the applicant as his own personal property and was neither acquired nor consigned for the purpose of resale.

(b) There shall be no fee imposed for the license. However, no physical address, location or property shall be permitted more than two such sales in a calendar year. No sale shall last longer than three consecutive days.

Section 66-34 Daily hours

Any sale conducted pursuant to the provision hereof shall be limited in time to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
